Birthing Kit Foundation Australia (BKFA) is an Australian charity dedicated to improving health outcomes for vulnerable women and babies around the world.

Through its birthing kit assembly program, BKFA offers a unique, hands-on volunteer experience for students and the opportunity for them to make a positive global impact.

The program highlights the health challenges that women in developing countries face when giving birth to their baby and encourages students to reflect and act on behalf of those less fortunate.

Who are we?

BKFA is dedicated to providing a clean and safe birthing environment for women in developing countries with the goal of eliminating maternal and newborn death and disease at the time of birth. We do this by raising funds for birthing kits and allocating them to our international field partners who distribute kits on our behalf to women in need.

What is the problem?

It is estimated that over 300,000 women and 3 million babies die annually in child birth, many from preventable infections. We assist women in the most challenging of situations – those who for reasons of isolation, cultural choice or lack of financial resources, are forced to give birth at home without adequate resources. By providing these women with the kit, they have the tools to give birth safely and reduce post-birth infection for themselves and their baby.

What is a birthing kit?

A kit contains six essential items endorsed by the World Health Organisation (WHO) to use when a delivery occurs at home. Items include a plastic birthing sheet, soap, disposable gloves, a scalpel blade, string cords and gauze.


All of this for just \$5.



Since 2006, BKFA has partnered with over 100,000 Australians to create and distribute 2 million clean birthing kits worldwide.
