The Clean Birth Kit Initiative



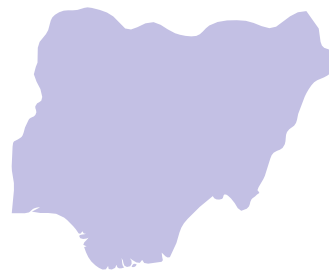
For more than 20 years, the Birthing Kit Foundation Australia has been working in partnership with the Australian Community to provide Clean Birth Kits to women and girls in need.

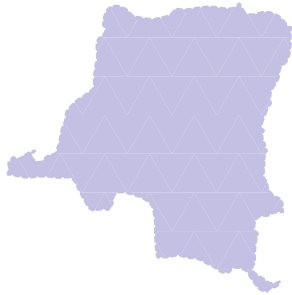

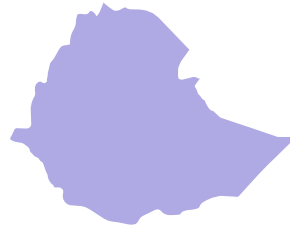

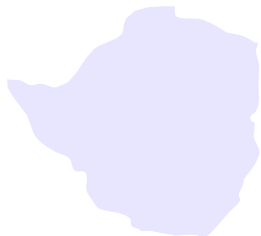
